When I get to the cash register, I tell the cashier, and she cracks up too. Fun day all around!





JUST GOOD CHOW By Connie N7RBH---Food tips and recipe: Want to bake the perfect amount of cookies? Mix up this recipe for carrot oatmeal cookies. Freeze time is two hours, cook time is eight minutes. Makes twenty eight cookies. ---- 2 cups quick or old fashioned oatmeal. 1 and ½ cups all purpose flower. 1 teas spoon baking soda, one tea spoon of salt. 4 table spoons promise buttery spread margarine. Two oz. of cream cheese, must be soft. Two oz cream cheese can be measured off the package. One large egg. One and ¼ cups firmly packed light brown sugar. One third cup low fat vanilla yogurt, one tea spoon of vanilla extract. One cup of raisins. A half cup shredded carrot (about one large carrot will do it).

Instructions: (1) Combine oats, baking soda, salt in a medium bowl. Set aside. (2) Beat the buttery spread with cream cheese and brown sugar in a large bowl with an electric mixer until it is creamy, about 3 minutes. Beat in the egg, yogurt, and vanilla, gradually put in the oats and other dry ingredients. Stir in raisons and carrots. (3) Turn the cookie dough on to wax paper, form into seven inch long rolls. Wrap tightly. Freeze for two hours. Preheat oven to 375 deg. Slice off a one inch round cookie dough on to a cooking sheet. Cook for 8 minutes or until golden brown.
