He shared his love for life and affection for animals, especially his 'Momma Kitty' cat who had been a stray. He brought her in and cared for her like a little Princess. He was a kind soul that for 41 years met his calling working in the morgue taking care of bodies. He used to say 'everybody cares for the living, but I'm going to take care of the dead', and he did so very caringly and honorably. I'm going to miss him saying, 'this is the guy who works in the morgue'. He was so proud of being chosen for that special job that he rarely missed a day of work (until last week). Johnnie was an 'lcon' at the hospital, one that will be irreplaceable.

The enormous knowledge he had in ham radio was incredible. He had an inquisitiveness about him that contributed to his knowledge. If he didn't know something, he would ask until he figured it out. Sometimes he would experiment until he got things just right. He loved working with all kinds of antennas and helped many others with theirs. Most of all, he loved being part of the OEN, and tried very hard to be 'solid' every month with the Net. He had a great sense of humor that could be heard on the radio at times. Yes, he will certainly be missed by everyone.

Sister Eileen (a special nun from the hospital who loved Johnnie too) told me while I was at the hospital that we should honor his life for the time we had to spend with him, and that provides some comfort to me. I'm glad I was part of Johnnie's life and the OEN family that he loved so much.
