SK REPORT Hi Dennis, As you know, I haven't had the radio on much so I don't know if you had this silent key: **Oregon broadcasting lost a true pioneer this month with the passing of "Buss" Jolley KA7ELJ.** Jule Leroy "Buss" Jolley, 94, died Feb. 18, at his Canyon City home. The announcement was in the weekly Oregon Association of Broadcasters newsletter.73, Jim, K7MKN

Dennis, Here is the complete obit: "Buss" Jolley was born June 3, 1919, in Abilene, Kansas, and graduated from Abilene High School in 1938, and attended Kansas State College. While pursuing a degree in journalism, he became interested in radio, and left school to work full-time for station KFBI in Wichita.

He married Dorothy Marie Dayhoff on Dec. 8, 1940.

On Sept. 9, 1942, he enlisted in the U.S. Army, and was assigned to the 906th Signal Corps, attached to the 11th Air Force, based at Elmendorf Field in Anchorage, Alaska.

Following his honorable discharge in 1945, the couple moved to Albany, Oregon where, after a short stint working in a plywood mill, he returned to radio as the program director for station KWIL. In 1957, he became station manager of KNPT in Newport, until moving on to KGAL in Lebanon.

That fall, Ted Smith, part-owner and manager of KUMA in Pendleton, and C.H. "Pop" Fisher, of Fisher Communications in Portland, hired him to bring a radio station to Grant County. He, and his family, moved to Canyon City, where he helped establish KJDY. He managed the station until his retirement in 1981.

His hobbies included fly fishing, woodworking, ham radio operation (KA7ELJ), gardening and his pets.

OEN APRIL 14 TH 2014 NOMINATION BUSINESS MEETING MINUTES

1. W7WX, the OEN Board Chairman, called the meeting to order using the W7OEN club call at 1900 PDT. He stated that this is an official OEN business meeting then turned it over to AG7K.
2. AG7K then called the board members call signs one at a time to see if they are present.
W7WX X, K7RFO X, K7SEG __, W7BXD X,
K7MKN __, KF7LN __, WA7JS X and AG7K X
3. AG7K stated that this is an “On the Air” OEN Business meeting for the purpose of securing nominations for the “at large” position presently held by K7MKN, and the SE director position held by K7RFO. Jim, K7MKN **is not** running for reelection so the position is open. Ruth, K7RFO **is** running for reelection. The minimum qualifications for eligibility for the “at large” position is to be an Oregon resident, be an OEN member in good standing, with an OEN certificate issued before April 15th, 2012. For the

SE Director position the same qualifications apply plus you need to reside in the SE district.

4. AG7K turned the meeting back to W7WX/W7OEN.

5. W7WX/W7OEN opened the floor to nominations for the “at large “position. WA7FIV nominated himself for the position and WA7JS nominated WA7OXM. W7BXD moved that nominations for the AT Large position be closed and was seconded by WA7JS. Motion was approved by a voice vote of the board.

6. W7WX/W7OEN opened the floor to nominations for SE director. ND7V nominated K7RFO. With no other nominees in evidence W7BXD moved to close the nominations and was seconded by WA7JS and approved by a voice vote of the board.

7. W7WX/W7OEN asked the nominees to submit an email ASAP to AG7K at W7OEN1@gmail.com verifying in writing that they intend to run. He

also stated that as soon as the email confirmations are received the election can (7) begin, hopefully the next day on April 15th. The election will be closed 15 days after it starts and the ballots counted. If you want to cast your ballot by US mail cut the ballot out of the Netter and send it to the address on the ballot.

8. W7WX/W7OEN asked if there is any other business for the meeting. With none stated W7BXD moved the meeting be closed with a second from AG7K and approved by voice vote of the board.

9. W7WX/W7OEN turned it over to KA7FHA for 2nd Net at 19:10 hours PDT
