Norman was born on December 20, 1934, in Longview, WA to William Olsen and Jessie (King) Olsen. His family lived in Longview, WA, Rainier, OR, then eventually moved to Cannon Beach, OR. Norman served in the U.S. Navy aboard the USS Bay Field APA-33 during the Korean War. In 1964, he met and married Catherine Utsler in Wenatchee, WA. They had three daughters. They moved to Portland, OR in 1967, and they lived there until 1978, when they returned to the Wenatchee Valley and made their home there.
