### 3 JUST NURISHING GRUB

#### Muskrat stew

First you have to get yourself a muskrat. That is easy. Just get a muskrat trap and set it out on Lost River along the bank, near Bonanza, Oregon. That is how I caught them in the good old days, I set the trap at their front door, the muskrat hole. I had a 12 foot wooden boat with oars, I used to roam that river with it when I was a boy. Also giggered a few frogs in those days, loved watching those frog legs jump around in the frying pan.

There was an old man along the river who loved to eat mud hens. I would shoot one for him now and then, and watch him as he cooked it up in a big pot. He was the one who told me how to make a muskrat stew.

After you trap the critter, you skin him, save the hide, you can get a few bucks for it. Take out all his insides, you can keep the heart and liver if you like. Boil him up for about 6 hours until he is good and tough. Shucks, you can even toss in the tail and hind feet if you want, makes for more food if you have to feed the whole family. Toss in a bunch of taters and onions, cook for another 6 hours, and put in a little rice. Rice always makes a meal go better. If there are some old folks there, the rice will be easy for them to get down if they do not have any teeth.

When you get it done, just dump it into a big pot and enjoy. Might even feed some to the dog, I used to test my cooking on the dog before I eat it. Let me know what you think of it, never got around to trying it myself.

#### JUST GOOD CHOW BY CONNIE N7RBH (From the K-A cookbook) CHOLATE DESERT

First layer: ½ cup oleo, 1 ¼ cup flower, ½ cup chopped nuts. Second layer: 8 oz pkg cream cheese, 1 cup powdered sugar, ½ cup Cool Whip (9 oz). Third layer: 3 cups milk, 2 boxes chocolate or any flavor instant pudding. First layer: Mix oleo, flour and chopped nuts. Press in bottom of 9 x 13 inch cake pan. Bake 10 minutes at 350 deg. Do not over bake. Cool thoroughly. Second layer: Blend ingredients together. Spread on cool crust in pan. Third layer: Whip together for 2 minutes. Spread on second layer.
