


Paul B. Carlin, 66, of Brookings, passed away suddenly Nov. 29, 2017. Paul was born in Oakland, California, to Bernard and Lucille Carlin.

He graduated from Bishop O'Dowd High School.

Paul joined the California Air National Guard and served in Vietnam. After the military, Paul was hired as an orderly at Doctors Hospital of San Leandro. It was at Doctors Hospital where he met Joy, the love of his life. They married in 1972.

Paul attended Merritt College in Oakland and graduated with a degree in radiologic technology. His first job with his degree was at Doctors Hospital of San Leandro. He operated one of the first C.T. and MRI scanners in the San Francisco's East Bay. He soon moved up to managing four imaging centers in Castro Valley, Oakland, Walnut Creek and Berkeley, all in California. He was an excellent manager and his employees loved him.
